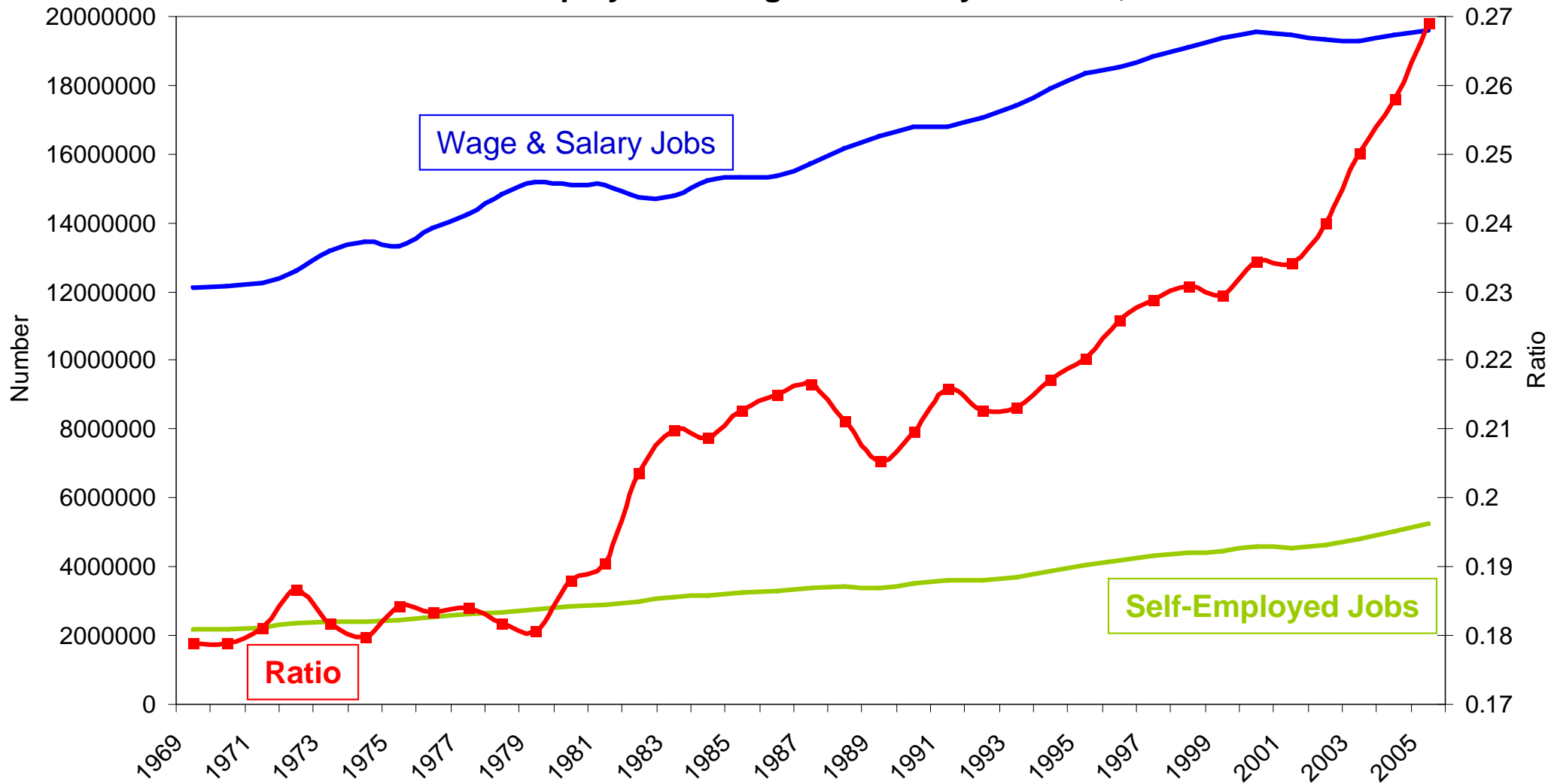
Today's youth* face...



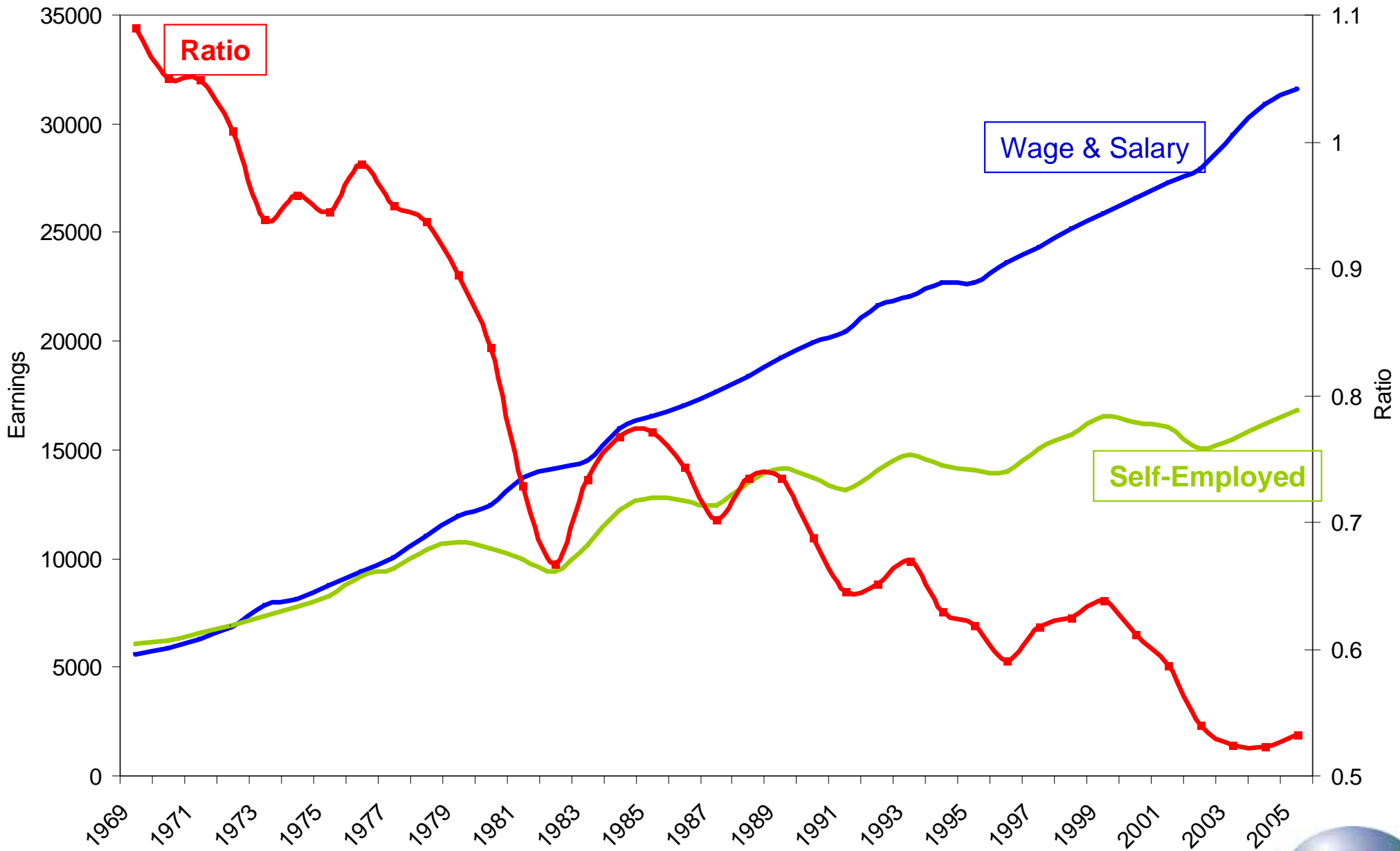
- Relatively lower standard of living – for the first time in American history

* Includes: *Millennials*: 18-29 years old today (80-95 million)

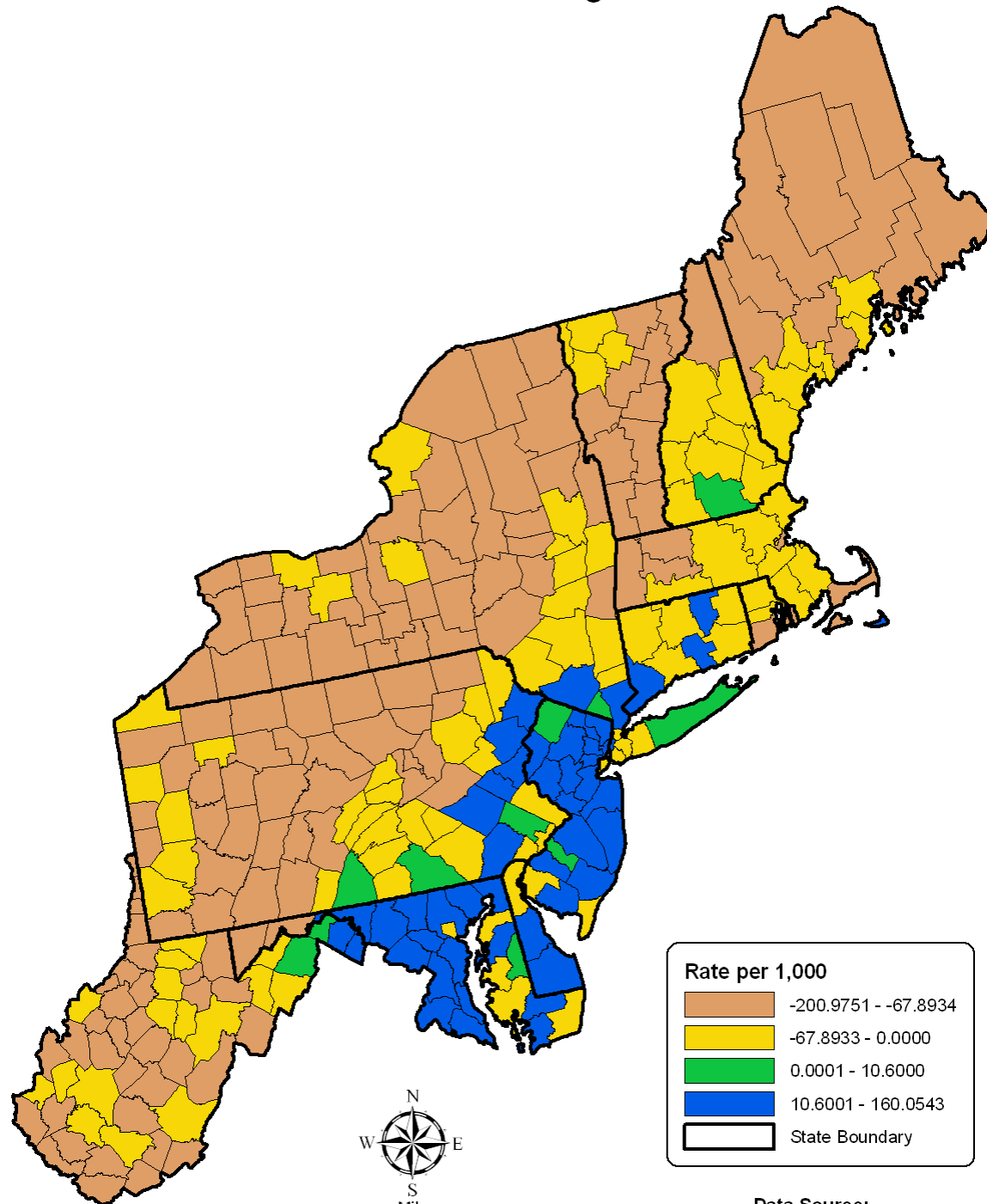
Figure 1: Trends in Rural Wage-and-Salary vs. Self-Employment Jobs, and Ratio of Self-Employed to Wage-and-Salary Workers, 1969-2005








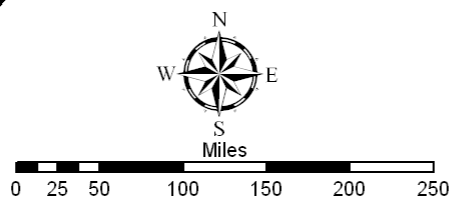
**Figure 2: Trends in Rural Nominal Earnings per Job:
