Overview

Agritourism is an opportunity for rural communities and farm operators to benefit from the growing consumer interest in on-farm experiences. NERCRD engages in several research and outreach efforts aimed at making this opportunity more accessible.



Selected Impacts

- A study led by NERCRD researchers found that the availability and adoption of high-speed broadband boosts the number of farms offering agritourism activities. They found that, on average, U.S. counties that adopted broadband speeds one megabit per second above the national average in 2012 had about 5% more agritourism operations in 2017 than counties that stayed at or below the national average speed. https://bit.ly/4715r56
- The researchers also found that agritourism and direct farm sales complement one another when they occur within the same community.
